Graduation Requirements: To graduate, participants must complete all course assignments and attend all scheduled classes. Participants who are unable to attend the Team Building Retreat will not be permitted to continue with the current class. Other missed classes can be made up with the following year's class.

Who Should Apply? Individuals who live or work in Hancock County and have a desire to become more involved in their community, wish to expand their knowledge of local issues, or want to develop more effective leadership skills.

Program Fees: The cost of the program is **\$525.00**. Fees are due when participants are notified they have been accepted to attend. Participants are usually recommended and sponsored by their employers or by a civic organization. However, individuals are welcome to apply.
